Fragrant Mountain™

Sarcococca humilis 'SarSid2' PP#19951, CPBR#3497

This delightful winter bloomer is a beautiful addition to shady areas in your garden, and an improvement upon the original variety, with its larger, glossy leaves. You will love the exotic fragrance of its delicate, fringe-like flowers. Fragrant Mountain™ makes a perfect border or entranceway plant. Deer resistant too!

- Glossy leaves are larger than the original form
- Excellent sub for Skimmia, with very similar habit and foliage, but lower maintenance costs
- No shot hole disease
- More resistant to yellowing caused by mites



Fragrant Valley™

Sarcococca humilis 'SarSid1' PP#19942, CPBR#3496

Fragrant Valley™ shares the same, low mounding habit as *Sarcococca humilis*, but improves upon the original with its fuller, denser, more vigorous form, and narrower, pointier leaves. Delicate, fringe-like flowers bloom in winter, perfuming the air with their exotic fragrance. Perfect for mass plantings, and deer resistant to boot!

- Beautiful addition to shady areas
- Same low, mounding habit as *Sarcococca humilis*, but with a denser, fuller, more vigorous form
- Foliage is narrower and pointier than the original form
- Fringe-like, fragrant flowers in winter
